



Code of Conduct for Junior Members

The Junior Member will:

- Play fairly and have fun
- Abide by the rules set down by team managers when travelling to away events.
- Behave in a manner that avoids bringing the game of tennis into disrepute.
- Respect officials and accept their decisions
- Talk to the children's officer if you have concerns
- Respect opponents and always shake hands at the end of a match
- Use his/her best efforts in competitive matches
- Refrain from the use of bad language and inappropriate gestures
- Refrain from ball/ racquet abuse
- Refrain from the use of coaching during competition
- Never use unfair or bullying tactics to gain advantage on or off the court
- Never use bullying tactics to isolate another player
- Never pass on gossip about another player or adult
- Never make false allegations about another player or adult
- Never keep secrets about anyone who has caused you harm
- Win with grace and lose with dignity
- Wear regulation tennis clothing and shoes during play
- Refrain from using the upstairs room (reserved for Senior members)
- Be off the Club premises by 18.00 each day (the Committee can from time to time award Senior playing privileges to certain promising Juniors. Junior members will be advised in writing if such privileges have been awarded and their names will be posted in the Clubhouse)
- Be permitted to bring Visitors to the Club according to the following conditions:
 - Permission to be obtained in advance from a Committee Member; Junior Co-Ordinator, Club Administrator or Junior Director of Tennis; payment of Visitors Fee (€5) and signing of Visitors Book (located in Junior Room).

N.B.: The disciplinary record of all members will be held on the Club's database.

The Junior Member has the right to:

- Be safe
- Be listened to
- Be respected
- Privacy
- Enjoy your sport in a protective environment
- Be referred to professional help if needed
- Be protected from abuse by another member or outside sources.
- Participate on an equal basis, appropriate to their ability
- Experience competition and the desire to win
- Be believed
- Ask for help
